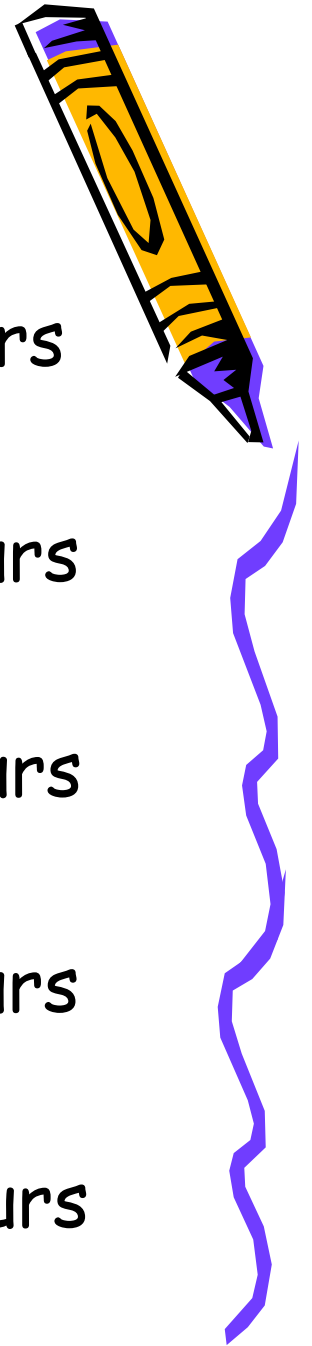
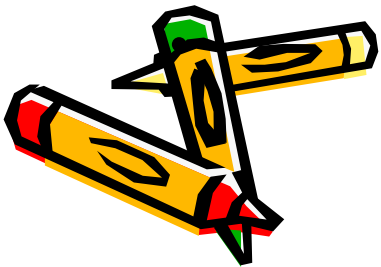
The Role of Dallas ISD in the SNS Internship- Process

Continue to Refine the Process



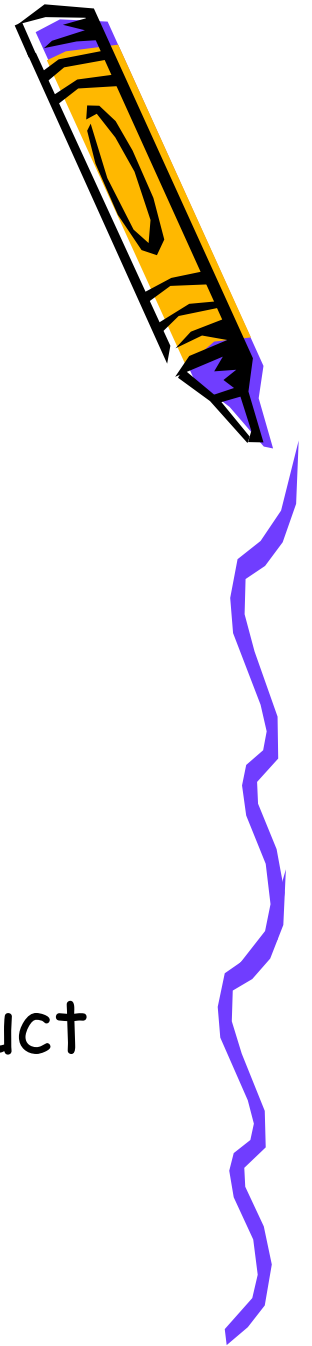
Components of the Objectives

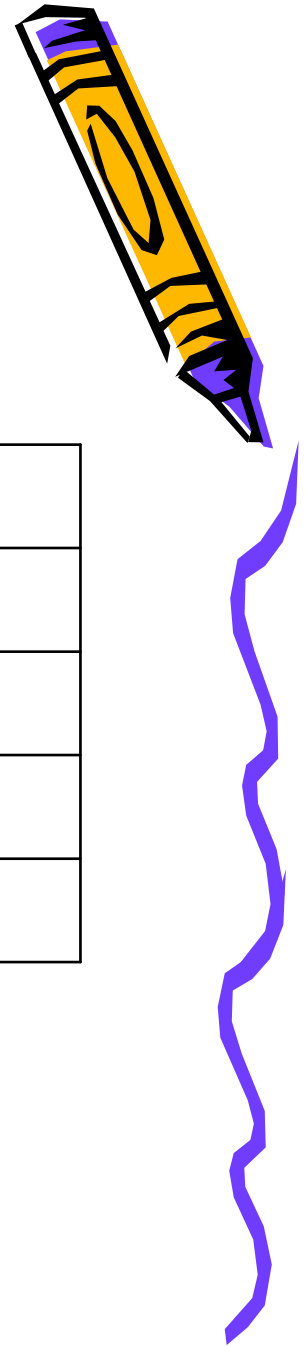


Tracking Student Hours

- Calendar log must be updated and submitted monthly

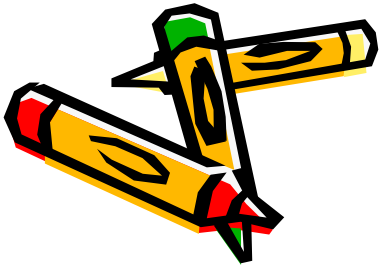


Tracking Calendar for Hours October 2008

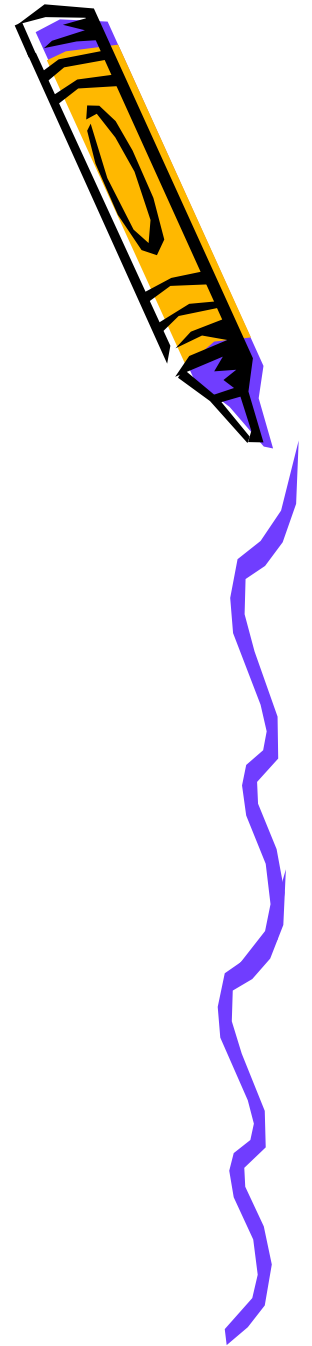
