WHY GET INVOLVED?

Kids:

Vote for School Lunch is a fun way to get kids involved in the voting process, especially in the build up to the 2008 presidential election.

Why you should Vote for School Lunch!

School lunches from the National School Lunch Program are good for kids. School Lunches:

- ★ Meet federal standards based on 'Dietary Guidelines for Americans'
- ★ Contain no more than 30 percent of calories from fat, and less than 10 percent from saturated fat over the course of one week
- ★ Provide one-third of the RDA of protein, Vitamin A, Vitamin C, iron, calcium, and calories
- ★ Are served in age-appropriate portion sizes
- ★ Are everywhere! In 180 School Days, 5 billion school lunches are served in 99,000 schools. That is approximately 30.6 million meals per day

In addition to electing the President of School Lunch, kids learn more about the healthy lunch options available in schools today.

Did you know that school lunches are healthier and tastier than ever! Meals from the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) are good for your children and help establish healthy eating habits for life. If you haven't been to your child's school cafeteria recently, it could be time for a fresh look!
